QUINTANA: We're going to call next Case 8443, in the matter of the hearing -- of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division on its own motion for an order creating, contracting, and extending certain pools in Lea, Roosevelt, and Chaves County, New Mexico.

Are there --

MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, my name is Jeff Taylor. I'm Counsel for the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, and I have one witness to be sworn.

MR. QUINTANA: Are there other appearances in this case?

If not, will you please stand up and be sworn in at this time?

(Hearing concluded.)

ERNIE BUSH,
being called as a witness and being duly sworn upon his oath, testified as follows, to-wit:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. TAYLOR:

Q Would you state your name and position for the record, please?

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A Mr. Examiner, my name is Ernie Bush. I'm a geologist for District III, New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Q Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission concerning the nomenclature of certain pools in Lea, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes, sir.

Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an exhibit?

A They are.

Q Would you please refer to this exhibit and to the docket that has been prepared and distributed at the hearing and point out any substantial difference between the two?

A There is a difference between the exhibit and the docket.

Paragraph (n), Lea County, Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Add Section, add to Section 24 the west half.

MR. QUINTANA: That would be all of Section 24, then.

Add to it would be just all of Section 24.

A That's -- that's correct.

Q Is that the only change in the exhibit on these particular counties?

A Yes, sir.

Q Do you have anything further to add to

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your testimony in regards to Lea, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties?

A I do not.

Q Was this exhibit prepared by you or under your supervision and control?

A Yes.

MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I'd like to move the admission of Exhibit A.

A Exhibit One.

MR. TAYLOR: I'd like to move the admission of Exhibit One with the change as testimony noted.

MR. QUINTANA: Exhibit One will be admitted into evidence with the change noted.

Q Are you also prepared to make recommendations to the Commission regarding the nomenclature of certain pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba, McKinley, and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes, I am.

Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an exhibit?

A They are.

Q Will you please refer to the exhibit and to the docket that has been prepared and distributed at the hearing and point out any substantial differences between the two?

A The difference between the exhibit and

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the docket, paragraph (q), West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool --

Q This is on page eight of our docket?

A It will be on page (q).

Q Oh, of the exhibit?

A Of the exhibit.

MR. QUINTANA: Are there some differences on that, Ernie?

A Yes, there are.

Township 25 North, 4 West, add to Section 36, south half of the southeast quarter and the north half.

Q So we should have the whole southeast quarter and the north half of that Section.

A That's -- that's correct.

Q Are there any other changes in --

A Yes. Please eliminate Exhibit (d), or (d) of Exhibit Two, excuse me.

Excuse me, Mr. Examiner, it's already been eliminated, I see.

Q But it is a change from the way it's printed in the docket, is it not?

A That is correct.

Q The subparagraph (d) on page six should be eliminated?

A That's right.

Q Are there any other changes that you'd like to make?

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A No, there are not.

Q Do you have anything further to add to your testimony?

A No, I don't.

Q Was Exhibit Two prepared by you or under your supervision and control?

A Yes, it was.

MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I'd like to move the admission of Exhibit Two with the changes as noted.

MR. QUINTANA: Exhibit Two will be entered into evidence with the change noted.

Q Is that all of your testimony?

A Yes, it is.

MR. QUINTANA: Is there anything further of the witness?

If not, he may be excused.

And Cases 8443 and 8444 will be taken under advisement.
