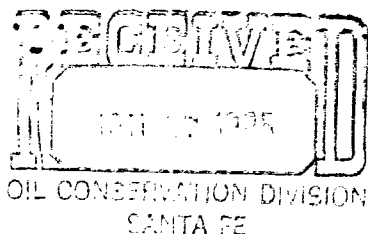

APPLICATION

Amerind Oil Co., by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an Order pooling all interests in the Strawn Formation underlying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, located in the Northeast Lovington - Pennsylvanian Pool, and in support thereof would show:

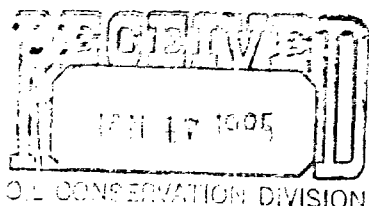
1. Applicant is entitled to proceed with the drilling of a well located in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, under the authority of Applicant's ownership of oil and gas leasehold or other interest or rights therein.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its well at a legal location in said E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, to a depth of approximately 11,600 feet to test the Strawn Formation and seeks to dedicate the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28 to the well. Applicant requested the parties listed on the attached schedule as owners of undivided mineral or leasehold interests in E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 to agree to lease, participate in the drilling of said well or to farmout or otherwise commit their interests to said well, but the parties so far have refused to do so.

3. Applicant seeks that the Division consider the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charge for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

4. The pooling of all interests underlying E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 is in the interest of conservation and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

5. Because of the fact that applicant has leases covering interests in the lands involved which leases have expiration dates early in 1985, the Applicant respectfully requests expeditious handling of the application and issuance of an order approving the application as soon as practicable.




6. Applicant respectfully requests the setting of this matter before the Division at its regular hearing on January 30, 1985.
