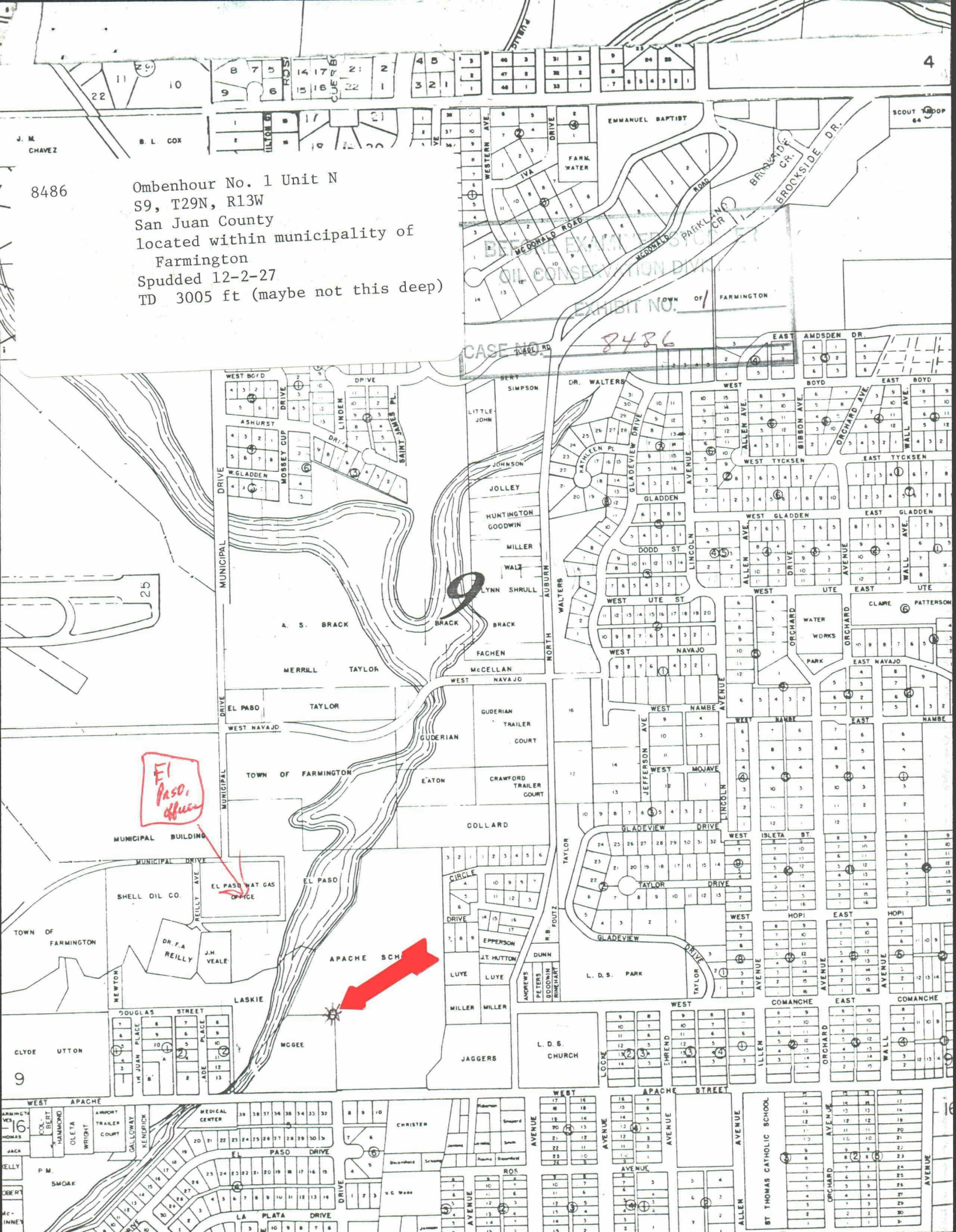

Presumed T.D. @ 3005'

1. Locate well.
2. Set a cement plug inside and outside casing, if present, from T.D. to 2600', to seal off Cliff House formation.
3. Set a cement plug inside and outside casing, if present, from 1300' to 1100', to seal Pictured Cliffs formation.
4. Set a cement plug inside and outside casing, if present, from 400' to surface, to seal off Farmington S.S.
5. Set dry hole marker.
6. Clean and restore location to original condition.
7. All plugs shall be of Class A, B, or C neat cement and may be accelerated by up to 3% CaCl_2 .
8. All plugs are to be separated by gel mud of minimum nine pounds per gallon.
