

The well was drilled to approximately 630 feet deep. No oil or Gas encountered. No log available, as operator died and his records not obtained.

Judgment in suit in District Court, San Juan County, in Cause #01827 awarded John Sparrow, mortgagee, a first lien on the casing in the above well (see certified copy of judgment attached) Parties to the action were Lien Claimant Elmer King, Vergie Schenck land owner, Mary Amenda Administrator of estate of J.E. Amenda and John Sparrow, mortgagee.

It is proposed to abandon and plug the well, following the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission, which will include filling the well in a compact manner with well mixed shale, and erection of a marker.



Presumed Downhole Equipment
6 5/8" casing set @ approx. 498'.
Hole filled with mixed shale.

1. Locate well bore.
2. Clean out/or drill out hole to approximately 630'.
3. Set a cement plug inside and outside casing from T.D. to surface.
4. Set dry hole marker.
5. Clean and restore location to original condition.
6. All plugs shall be of Class A, B, or C neat cement and may be accelerated by up to 3% CaCl_2 .
