

APPLICATION

Comes now, HARBEN-DAVIS, a partnership, by and through its undersigned attorneys and, as provided by §70-2-17, N.M.S.A. (1978), hereby makes application for an order pooling all of the mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Abo Reef (approximate depth 8500 feet) in and under the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 22, Township 16 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant owns or represents approximately 70.05% of the working interest in and under the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 22, and applicant has the right to drill thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled unit to a well to be drilled at an orthodox location in said Section 22.

3. Applicant has sought and obtained either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from all other interest owners in the SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 22, except the following mineral interest owners:

4. Said pooling of interest and well completion will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled, and applicant should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on February 27, 1985, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the

lands, including provisions for applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, and imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by the applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may be proper in the premises.
