Comes now, DOYLE HARTMAN, by and through his undersigned attorneys and, as provided by Section 70-2-17, N.M.S.A. (1978), hereby makes application for an order pooling all of the mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Jalmat Pool, in and under the NW/4 of Section 8, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Division:

- 1. Applicant owns or represents approximately 58.3% of the working interest in and under the NW/4 of said Section 8, and applicant has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to simultaneously dedicate the above-referenced pooled unit to the existing E. E. Jack No. 1 Well located in Unit E of said Section 8 and its E. E. Jack No. 5 well to be drilled at an orthodox location in Unit D of said Section 8.
- 3. Applicant has sought and obtained either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from all other interest owners in the NW/4 of said Section 8, except those interest owners set out on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by

reference.

4. Said pooling of interests and well completion will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and

will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the applicant to obtain his just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the

mineral interests should be pooled, and applicant should be

approving the location of the well as proposed by applicant, and

making such other and further provisions as may be proper in the

premises.
