

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on August 28, 1985, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this ____ day of September, 1985, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, H.L. Brown Jr., seeks a special gas-oil ratio limitation of 10,000 to one, retroactive to April 1, 1982, for the Feather-Morrow Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That said Feather-Morrow Pool is currently a three-well pool of unknown extent being developed by applicant's State UTP No. 3 located in Unit P of Section 6, and Santa Fe Energy Company's State UTP No.'s 2 and 3 located in Units G and J, respectively, of Section 21, Township 15 South, Range 32 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico.

(4) That the evidence presently available indicates that said Feather-Morrow Pool may be produced at a limiting gas-oil ratio of 10,000 to one without waste.

(5) That the application for special gas-oil ratio limitation should be approved affective April 1, 1982.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That effective April 1, 1982, a special gas-oil ratio of 10,000 cubic feet of gas per barrel of oil is hereby established for the Feather-Morrow Pool, as heretofore defined and described, in Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

Gentlemen:

Attached are approved copies of Form C-105 for your State UTP Well No. 3 located in Unit P of Section 16, T-15-S, R-32-E.

We concur that this well appears to be an oil well with a high gas-oil ratio. Since it offsets the Feather Morrow Oil Pool, however, it will be considered as a development well for that pool rather than as a wildcat as shown on Form C-105. It will, of course, be necessary to submit Form C-104 requesting an allowable before sales are made from the well.

Since the wells in this pool seem to be increasing in gas-oil ratio, you may want to consider the possibility of going to hearing to obtain an increased gas-oil ratio limit for the pool.
