


Dear Mr. Stamets:

Dear Mr. Stamets:

Our firm represents Mr. Lewis Burleson who appeared in opposition to Mr. Hartman's referenced case originally heard by the Division on October 9, 1985. Thereafter Division Order R-8107 was entered, copy enclosed.

The DeNovo hearing of this case is now set for April 9, 1986. However, we have been advised by Mr. Hartman's attorney that he is seeking a continuance of this case to the Commission's May, 1986, docket.

Mr. Burleson understands that Mr. Hartman is producing his Carlson-Harrison Federal Com wells. We do not know if Mr. Hartman is producing these wells in compliance with the examiner order or whether he is producing in excess of the allowable limitations required in the Examiner Order.

We do not want to be in a position where Mr. Hartman is producing his wells in excess of the allowable provided for in the Examiner order while at the same time having a final decision in this case postponed, all in violation of Mr. Burleson's correlative rights.

Therefore, Mr. Burleson is opposed to having this case continued and would like the matter heard on April 9, 1986.
