APPLICATION

Amerind Oil Company hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location to be drilled at a point 1350 feet from the east line and 1650 feet from the north line in Section 35, Township 14 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, to test the Pennsylvanian formation at a depth of approximately 10,700 feet from the surface.

2. The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35 is to be dedicated to the well.

3. Approval of the unorthodox well location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

4. Applicant requests that this matter be heard at the September 11, 1985 Examiner hearing.
