On November 5, 1985, the Oil Conservation Division entered Order No. R-8074 in the above-referenced case granting the application of Yates Petroleum Corporation to pool all interests from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the top of the Pre-Cambrian formation underlying the S/2 of Section 27, Township 2 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Roosevelt County, New Mexico. This order provided that the operator of the unit should commence the drilling of a well on this tract on or before the 31st day of January, 1986. Following the entry of the pooling order, Yates Petroleum Corporation made arrangements to assign its interest in this tract therefore changing the operator designated by Order R-8074. On February 3, 1986, we received a letter from you confirming our conversation of January 30, 1986, in which you extended for 60 days Order R-8074.

This letter is to request an additional extension of Order R-8074 through April 30, 1986. The reason for this request is that Marshall Pipe & Supply Company is seeking amendment of Order R-8074 to designate it as operator of the spacing and proration unit. This matter has been docketed as Case 8867 and is scheduled for hearing on April 2, 1986. It is my understanding that a rig is available and that work on the well will commence in the next few days.
