Dear Florean:

In our conversation on March 4, 1986 I requested an indefinite postponement on the hearing for conversion to waste water disposal for the above mentioned well. In earlier conversations with the OCD, Coquina was told that it would have to re-enter the Werthiem #1 well and set plugs at various intervals. First off this well is on another lease; which is operated by Exxon. Second off Coquina feels that entering a wellbore on someone elses lease would be cause for a lawsuit.

For these reasons Coquina has no alternative but to look elsewhere for disposal of its waste water.
