Comes now, FRANK BOYCE, d/b/a SURE ENERGY, by its under-  
signed attorneys, and hereby makes application for an order  
designating a new pool as a result of the discovery of hydro-  
carbons in the Delaware formation in its Connie (C) State No. 1  
Well located in Unit G of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 28  
East, Eddy County, New Mexico, and for promulgation of special  
pool rules, including a special gas-oil ratio of 20,000 to 1, and  
a discovery allowable for its Connie (C) State No. 1 Well, and in  
support of this application would show the Division:

1. Applicant has recently completed its Connie (C) State  
No. 1 Well in the Delaware formation capable of producing oil and  
gas in paying quantities located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 25,  
Township 19 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said  
well was potentialled as capable of producing 20 barrels of oil  
per day, 320 mcf of gas per day and 40 barrels of produced water.

2. Applicant believes that the following described lands  
are reasonably proven to be productive of oil and gas in paying

quantities from the Delaware formation and should be included in the original definition of the new pool to be created because of said recovery:

Township 19 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M.  
Section 25: S/2 NE/4

3. In order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, special pool rules and regulations providing for a gas-oil ratio limitation of 20,000 cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil produced should be promulgated for the new pool.

4. Applicant respectfully requests that a discovery allowable be assigned to its Connie (C) State No. 1 Well.

WHEREFORE, Frank Boyce, d/b/a Sure Energy requests that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on January 22, 1986, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that after hearing the application be approved.
