



COMES NOW Yates Petroleum Corporation, by its attorneys, and in support hereof, respectfully states:

- "ADR" State No. 1 Well, located in Unit Letter I, 1,650 feet from the south line and 990 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This oil well produces from the Queen interval through perforations from 3,767 feet to 3,774 feet. Applicant herein seeks to have such discovery well designated to justify creation of a new pool for Queen oil production to be known as the Sanmal Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. Since completion of the discovery well, and in confirmation thereof, Applicant completed its Sweet Thing "AEB" State No. 1 Well, located in Unit Letter J, 1,980 feet from the south line and 1,980 feet from the east line of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico,

- on July 4, 1986. This oil well produces from the Queen interval through perforations between 3,744 feet and 3,761 feet.
- 3. Such wells are not located within an existing pool for Queen production, nor within one mile from any such existing pool.
- 4. Applicant requests that such pool rules be temporary, to be reviewed after one year of production history, and to permit a Gas-Oil Ratio of 5,000 cubic feet per barrel of oil, without penalty on the production allowable otherwise permitted under Rule 505 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Such Gas-Oil Ratio is in excess of that otherwise permitted under Rule 506.
- 5. Approval of this Application will be in the interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays:

- A. That this Application be set for hearing before an examiner and that notice of said hearing be given as required by law.
- B. That upon hearing the Division enter its order creating the Sanmal Queen Pool for oil production from the Queen formation as discovered by Applicant's Hoover "ADR" State No. 1 Well, and establishing temporary special pool rules for such pool, to be reviewed after one year of production history, permitting a Gas-Oil Ratio of 5,000 cubic feet per barrel of oil,

without penalty on the production allowable otherwise permitted under Rule 505 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

C. And for such other and further relief as may be just in the premises.
