The captioned case is on the docket for November 18, 1987. The temporary relief from the statewide rule on gas-oil ratio accorded to the applicant by the Division one year ago has served its purpose. The well in question has stabilized at a gas-oil ratio in the range of eight hundred to twelve hundred thousand cubic feet per barrel of oil. The applicant therefore believes that it would now be appropriate for the standard rule to apply to the operation of the well and pool in question. We therefore do not plan to attend the hearing on the 18th unless you desire that we do so.
