Dear Frank:

I am in receipt of Supplement to the Oil Proration Schedule No. 3055/X dated August 11, 1986 but mailed to Geo Engineering, Inc. on August 25, 1986. The schedule indicates that the allowables for Geo Engineering, Inc. wells in the Chaco Wash Mesaverde Pool in McKinley County have been cancelled for failure to file the Operators Monthly Report.

It is my understanding that all past due C-115's were filed by Geo Engineering with the Santa Fe office on August 20, 1986. I am unaware if copies of those filings were made available to the District Office in Aztec.

In any event, I understand that Geo Engineering is now current on its C-115 filings. Accordingly, we would request that the allowables for Geo Engineering's wells in the Chaco Wash Mesaverde Pool be reinstated. If for some reason the reinstatement is not possible, I would appreciate your advising me why such is not possible.
