Please docket a case calling for Texas Rose Petroleum Corp., Travelers Insurance Companies and all other interested parties to appear and show cause why the El Poso Ranch #1, located 1824' from the south line and 1778' from the east line of Section 14, 28 North, 1 East, the El Poso Ranch #2, located 618' from the south line and 2418' from the west line of Section 14, 28 North, 1 East, the El Poso Ranch #3, located 967' from the south line and 2148' from the west line of Section 11, 28 North, 1 East, the El Poso Ranch #7, located 990' from the south line and 2310' from the west line of Section 14, 28 North, 1 East, and the El Poso Ranch #8, located 2310' from the south line and 2310' from the west line of Section 14, 28 North, 1 East, should not be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a Division approved plugging program.

APPLICATION

Suntex Energy Corporation applies for an order vacating or modifying Division Order No. R-8404, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the following wells in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico:

- a. Well No. 1, in Unit J of Section 14;
- b. Well No. 2, in Unit N of Section 14;
- c. Well No. 3, in Unit N of Section 11;
- d. Well No. 7, in Unit O of Section 14; and
- e. Well No. 8, in Unit K of Section 14,

all in Township 28 North, Range 1 East, N.M.P.M., as projected into the unsurveyed Tierra Amarilla Land Grant.

2. The above wells were formerly operated by Texas Rose Petroleum, Inc., under a joint venture with applicant. Due to the default of Texas Rose Petroleum, Inc., applicant is now entitled to operate the aforesaid wells.

3. By Order No. R-8404, the Division ordered Texas Rose Petroleum, Inc. and its surety to properly plug and abandon the above-identified wells by March 30, 1987, or to complete or recomplete the wells within 180 days of said

date under a plan approved by the Aztec district office not later than March 30, 1987.


4. Applicant was unable to file a plan to complete or recomplete the wells within the time permitted, but now desires and is able to complete or recomplete said wells within a reasonable time.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that the Division vacate Order No. R-8404, or in the alternative to modify said order to allow applicant to complete or recomplete said wells within a reasonable time to be fixed by the Division.
