Gentlemen:

Phillips Petroleum Company, an offset operator, has reviewed the subject application filed by I & W, Inc., dated March 12, 1987, and respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Division require I & W, Inc. to run a radioactive tracer survey upon conversion of the subject well to injection service. Phillips is concerned that the condition of the Walter Solt State Well No. 1 wellbore may not confine the injection fluids in the Wolfcamp formation and could possibly allow fluids to flow into the Cisco formation.

Phillips Petroleum Company would have no objections to the granting of a permit if the results of a radioactive tracer survey confirmed that injection was into the Wolfcamp only. If the order granting the permit does not require I & W, Inc. to conduct a radioactive survey, then Phillips Petroleum Company wishes to protest the application by I & W, Inc. and requests the Oil Conservation Division set the aforementioned application for Examiner's Docket.
