Dear Mr. LeMay:

On behalf of Sun Exploration and Production Company, please enter our appearance in Case 9134 which is set for hearing on the Commission docket of May 21, 1987.

Except in certain compulsory pooling cases and in statutory unitization cases, there is no legal necessity for, nor a practical means, by which royalty owners can or should be notified of Commission Cases. Royalty owners in Division cases should and are represented by their respective operators and working interest owners to whom they have contracted the right to explore and develop their respective leases.

In addition, we move to dismiss Case 9134 for the failure of the Division's staff to file a written application prior to ten days before the hearing pursuant to Rule 1203.
