It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-8480 dated July 23, 1987, does not clearly state the intended order of the Division,


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Decretory Paragraph No. (4) on pages 4 and 5 of Division Order No. R-8480, dated July 23, 1987, be and the same is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:


"(4) The applicant is entitled to a 142 barrel a day allowable effective January 24, 1987, and any overproduction which has accumulated since January 24, 1987, is to be made up by producing the well at a rate of 100 barrels per day, from date of this order, until said overproduction has been eliminated."

(2) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro tunc as of July 23, 1987.
