

Comes now TEXACO PRODUCING, INC., by and through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant is the operator of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., and proposes to drill a well at a point 860 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 1.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Oil Conservation Division Rules 104 to permit the drilling of the well at the above-described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations.

3. A standard 80 acre spacing unit comprising the E/2 SE/4 of said Section 1 should be dedicated to the well.


4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Pennsylvanian and Devonian formations and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste.

Comes now TEXACO PRODUCING, INC., by and through its undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox well location, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant is the operator of the E/2 SE/4 of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., and proposes to drill a well at a point 860 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 1.

2. Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Oil Conservation Division Rules 104 to permit the drilling of the well at the above-described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Pennsylvanian, Devonian and McKee Sandstone formations.

3. A standard 320 acre spacing unit comprising the S/2 of said Section 1 should be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of this application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Pennsylvanian, Devonian and McKee Sandstone formations and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste.
