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MR. STOGNER: Call next Case Number 9157, which is the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division on its own motion for an order creating and extending certain pools in Chaves and Lea Counties, New Mexico.

ROY JOHNSON,

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. TAYLOR:

Q Will you please state your name, position, and place of residence?

A My name is Roy Johnson. I'm a geologist with New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe, New

3 fied before the Commission or its examiners and had your
4 credentials accepted?

5 A I have.

6 MR. TAYLOR: I tender the wit-
7 ness as an expert.

8 MR. STOGNER: Mr. Johnson is so
9 qualified.

10 Q Mr. Johnson, are you prepared to make re-
11 commendations to the Examiner today concerning the nomencla-
12 ture of certain pools in Chaves and Lea Counties, New
13 Mexico?

14 A I am.

15 Q Are your recommendations prepared in the
16 form of an exhibit?

17 Q They are. It is labeled Exhibit One.

18 A Exhibit One. Would you please then refer
19 ot Exhibit One and to the docket that's been prepared and
20 distributed at the hearing and point out any difference be-
21 tween the two?

22 A There are no differences between the ex-
23 hibit and the docket; however, we would request that para-
24 graph (e), that paragraph, the creation of the East Shoe Bar
25 Pennsylvanian Pool, be dismissed.

1 Q Okay, so we -- to make the docket correct
2 we would delete all of paragraph (e).

3 A Yes, sir.

4 Q Do you have anything further to add to
5 your testimony?

6 A I do not.

7 Q Have you reviewed te contents of Exhibit
8 One and assured yourself of its accuracy?

9 A Yes.

10 MR. TAYLOR: We tender Exhibit
11 One.

12 MR. STOGNER: Exhibit One will
13 be admitted into evidence at this time.

14 MR. TAYLOR: That's all we have
15 in this matter.

16 MR. STOGNER: There being no
17 other questions of Mr. Johnson, he may be excused.
