Dear Mr. Stogner:

At the August 12, 1987 hearing on the above case I believe we gave the impression that under the terms of a farm-out from Marshall and Winston, Inc., Terra Resources had thirty days from either the hearing or date of entry of the order in which to spud a well in order to preserve the farm-out acreage. Terra Resources now advises that it had obtained an extension of its Marshall and Winston farm-out until October 17, 1987. Thus, the expiration date is, in fact, fixed and does not allow thirty days from whatever date the Division enters its order.

In view of the above, Terra Resources maintains its request for an expedited order.
