COMES NOW the Affiant, Charles A. Robinson, Jr., and makes application for a treating plant permit pursuant to Rule 312 of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division.

That the Applicant, Charles A. Robinson, Jr., d/b/a Jamar, seeks authority to construct and operate a chemical and heat treatment type oil treating plant in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 8, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, for the reclamation of up to two hundred (200) barrels of sediment oil per day to be obtained from tank bottoms, disposal water, and waste pits.

The plat and diagrammatic plant layout are attached hereto.

All unmerchantable solids or liquids shall be disposed of by approved methods for disposal as required by the Division.

The bond as required by the Division is attached hereto.


All notices pursuant to the Rules and Regulations of the Division have been given.


PLANT LOCATION
