- 1. Applicant is the operator of the Delaware, Wolfcamp, Strawn, Atoka and Morrow formations underlying the N/2 of Section 8, Township 25 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and proposes to drill a well at a point 660 feet from the Nouth line and 860 feet from the East line of said Section 8.
- 2. Applicant seeks an exception to the Division's well location requirements to permit the drilling of the well at the above-described unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test the Delaware, Wolfcamp, Strawn, Atoka and Morrow formations.
