APPLICATION

COMES NOW Marshall Pipe & Supply Company, by its attorneys, and in support hereof, respectfully states:

1. Applicant is the operator of all formations from the surface through the base of the Ordovician formation, underlying:

Township 2 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 34: N/2

containing 320 acres, more or less,
and proposes to drill its Cook No. 1 Well, at a point located 330 feet from the north line and 1,980 feet from the east line of said Section 34, and to dedicate said N/2 to the well.

2. The Applicant seeks an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104 of the Oil Conservation Division to permit the drilling of the well at the above mentioned unorthodox location to a depth sufficient to adequately test all formations

from the surface through the base of the Ordovician formation, which may be developed on 320-acre spacing.

3. A standard 320-acre proration unit comprising the N/2 of said Section 34 should be dedicated to such well or to such lesser portion thereof as is reasonably shown to be productive of oil and gas.

4. The approval of this Application will afford Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of oil and gas, will prevent economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays:

A. That this Application be set for hearing before an examiner and that notice of said hearing be given as required by law.

B. That upon hearing the Division enter its order granting Applicant permission to drill its Cook No. 1 Well at a point 330 feet from the north line and 1,980 feet from the east line of said Section 34, and to dedicate the N/2 of Section 34 to said well.

C. And for such other and further relief as may be
just in the premises.
