



ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on March 16, 1988, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this 23rd day of March, 1988, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Metex Pipe and Supply, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its State "P" Well No. 3 to be drilled 100 feet from the North line and 1520 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 24, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) The applicant proposes to dedicate a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit consisting of the NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 24 to the above described well.

(4) The applicant presented testimony and evidence which indicates that the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company State "P" Well No. 2 located 330 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 24 was drilled in 1945 and was subsequently completed in the Wilson Yates-

It is requested that the above forementioned order be ammended to name the well as the No. 6 State "P".

Spudded Well 3/28/88, with L&M Rig #2 and set 353'-36#-9-5/8" Casing - Cemented with 175-Sxs Howco Premium Plus w/2% CaCl. Circulated 35-Sxs to pits. WOC 18-Hrs and drilled out shoe and tested to 1000# for 15-min - Held OK.

Will bring cement back to 9-5/8" surface casing when cementing the 7" Casing.

Stuck drill string in red beds at 1257' and spent 4 1/2-days washing over and recovering the drill string.

4-6-88, Approximately 2200' this AM and drilling with full returns.


