Robert N. Enfield, by his undersigned attorneys hereby makes application for an Order pooling all interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 19, Township 18 south, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support of its application would show:

1. Applicant is the working interest owner of certain interests in the S/2 of Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant intends to operate a well to be located at a standard location in the S/2 of Section 19.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to join all other working interest owners in the S/2 of Section 19 for the purpose of forming a 320 acre proration unit in the S/2 of Section 19.

4. Although Applicant has attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all working interest owners to dedicate their mineral interests to the 320 acre unit, there remain some working interest owners who have refused to join in dedicating their acreage to the unit.

5. Applicant seeks an Order from the Division pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow



9. Applicant requests that this matter be set for the July 12, 1989 Examiner Hearing of the Oil Conservation Division.

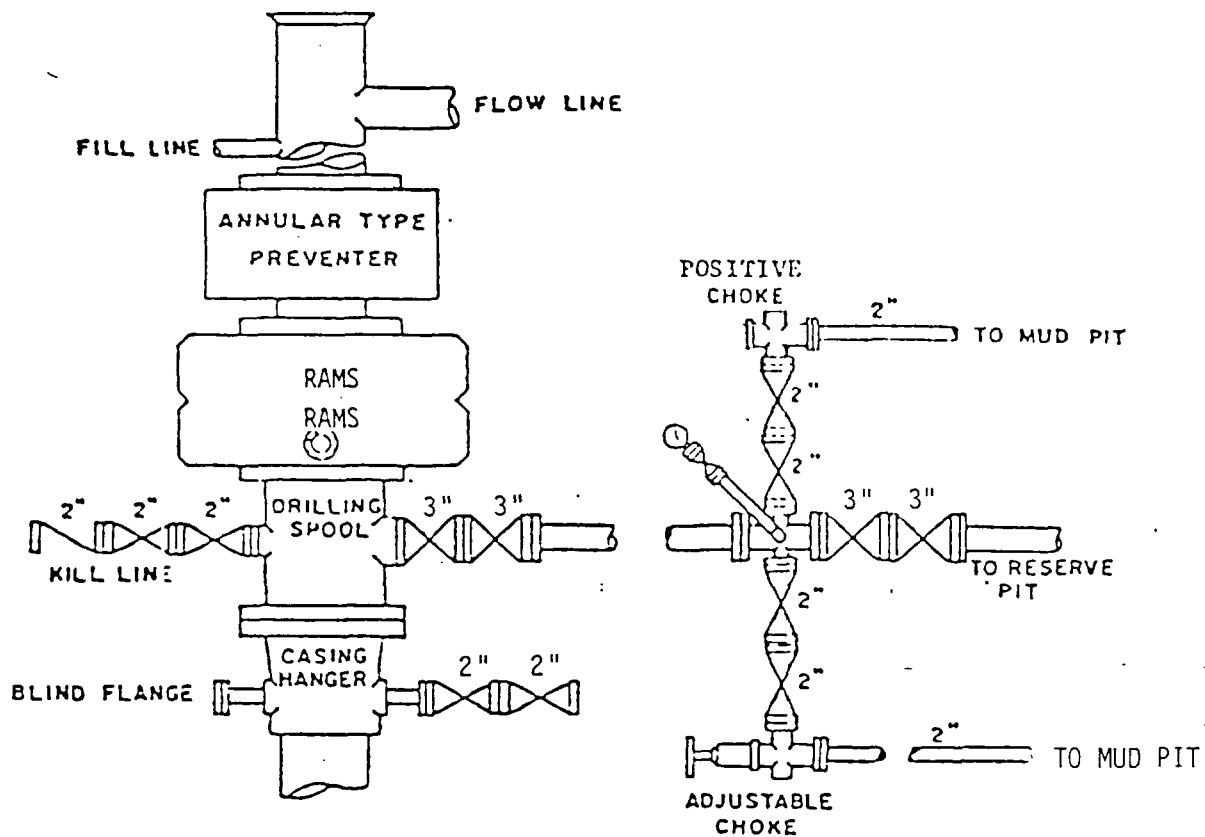


BOP STACK
