COMES NOW Yates Petroleum Corporation, by its attorneys, and in support hereof, respectfully states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the following lands in Chaves County, New Mexico:

Township 4 South, Range 20 East, N.M.P.M.

Sections 1 through 3: All  
Sections 10 through 15: All  
Sections 17 through 36: All

Township 4 South, Range 21 East, N.M.P.M.

Sections 6 through 7: All  
Sections 18 through 19: All

Township 5 South, Range 20 East, N.M.P.M.

Sections 1 through 12: All

containing 28,800 acres, more or less.

2. The Applicant seeks to commit the above described lands to an exploratory unit known as the Cowboy Draw Unit. The unit consists of federal and state lands.

3. The ratification or approval of all leasehold owners, including the State of New Mexico, required to ratify such unit agreement will be forthcoming prior to the effective date of any order issued pursuant to this Application by the Division.

4. The approval of this Application is in the interest of conservation and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays:

A. That this Application be set for hearing before an examiner and that notice of said hearing be given as required by law.

B. That upon hearing, the Division enter its order approving the Cowboy Draw Unit Agreement, with Applicant as operator, as an exploratory unit embracing the above described lands.

C. And for such other and further relief as may be just in the premises.
