NOW, on this 24th day of June, 1991, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the record and being fully advised in the premises,

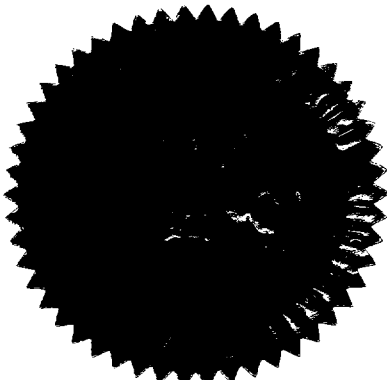
FINDS THAT:
