

Gentlemen:

This letter shall evidence in writing the agreement between Mewbourne Oil Company (Mewbourne) and Enron Oil and Gas Company (Enron) concerning Mewbourne's unorthodox location application for the Cedar Breaks 2 State No. "2" well.

- 1) Enron agrees to immediately withdraw its protest of Mewbourne's unorthodox location for the Cedar Breaks 2 State "2" well located 990' FNL & 990' FEL of NE/4 of Section 2-18S-30E and hereby consents to said location waiving all objections thereto.
- 2) In consideration of Enron dropping its protest, Mewbourne agrees to grant Enron a one (1) time waiver for one (1) well located no closer than 990' from the end and 660' from the side boundary of any 320 acre spacing unit that is contiguous to Sec. 2-18S-30E for a period of one year from January 1, 1993.
- 3) Mewbourne agrees to furnish Enron with well information 30 days from the completion of the Cedar Breaks 2 State No. "2" well. Enron agrees to furnish Mewbourne with well information 30 days from completion of any well that Enron drills at an unorthodox location in which Mewbourne grants a waiver to as set out above.
- 4) It is agreed and understood that it is the intent of Mewbourne but not the obligation to drill the Cedar Breaks "2" State No. 2 well and that the foregoing sets forth the entire agreement between the parties and that there are no verbal or oral agreements between the parties not set out in writing herein.







Mewbourne Oil Company finds it necessary to apply for and receive administrative approval of an unorthodox location to drill an 11,600' Morrow well on its Loco Hills Prospect located in Section 2, T18S, R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. A location of 990' FEL (nearest side boundary) and 990' FNL (nearest end boundary) in this section would give Mewbourne Oil Company the opportunity to encounter a sufficient amount of net Lower Morrow Sand porosity to make a commercial well.

Enclosed you will find a Lower Morrow Structure/Isopach map and Morrow Cross Section A-A'. The map shows our proposed unorthodox location with an open circle while a standard location is marked by an "X". As you can see from the Isopach map, the Lower Morrow Brown Sand identified on Cross Section A-A' has a greater likelihood of being thick enough to be productive in the northeast corner of this section. Conversely a standard location would not give Mewbourne Oil a reasonable chance to meet it's minimum thickness of 10' of porous sand needed to have a reasonable expectation of economic success.


The unorthodox location Mewbourne Oil seeks will be almost a mile from the nearest producing Morrow gas well, the Enron Oil and Gas Company Cedar Lake "35" Federal Com. #1 (location B, Section 35, 17S, 30E), which has just been drilled and completed this year. 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


