#### STATEMENT OF CASE

#### APPLICANT:

Meridian Oil Inc. seeks approval to downhole commingle Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool and Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool production within the wellbore of it proposed San Juan 29-7 Unit #583 Well to be drilled at a standard gas well location in Unit L of Section 6, T29N, R7W, San Juan County New Mexico. As set forth in its application, Meridian will establish, among other things, that:

- (1) Ownership is common to both spacing units and thus correlative rights will not be impaired;
- (2) The Fruitland Coal Gas and the Pictured Cliffs gas at this location cannot economically be produced in any other means than downhole commingling; and
  - (3) No reservoir damage will occur.

The proposed Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool spacing unit is the W/2 equivalent of Section 6 being 215.22 acres. The proposed Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool spacing unit is the SW/4 equivalent of Section 6 being 110.66 acres. Both are non-standard in size for their respective pools and require approval as non-standard spacing units. Section 6 is "undersized" and therefore makes the non-standard unit necessary in order to confine the spacing units to acreage
