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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 9:07 a.m.: 2 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Okay, we shall now call Case 3 10,907, which is in the matter called by the Oil 4 Conservation Division to amend Rule Number 111, 1112 and 5 1115 of its general rules and regulations. Mr. Carroll, do you have a recommendation on Case 10,907? 8 9 MR. CARROLL: May it please the Commission, my name is Rand Carroll, appearing on behalf of the Division. 10 There's a typo in this advertisement. It is Rule 11 1111 and 1112 and 1115. 12 At the October Commission meeting, an order 13 amending Rule 1115 was entered. We still have a little bit 14 of cleanup in this case. 15 16 I request that this case be continued to the 17 December Commission hearing and that an order be issued amending Rules 1111 and 1112 to provide for the same filing 18 date as that provided for Rule 1115, which is the 15th day 19 20 of the second month, rather than the 15th day of the succeeding month. 21 So I think the Commission could clean this case 22 up and finish it off by just amending those two rules to 23 provide for the new filing date. 24 Is it -- It's my understanding 25 CHAIRMAN LEMAY:

1 that this interim order is in force now that extends the filing date on the C-111 and C-112 to the 15th of the day 2 following the month of production. 3 MR. CARROLL: 15th day of the second month. 4 5 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Of the second month following 6 the --7 MR. CARROLL: And that interim order is in effect until these rules are amended. So that interim order will 8 remain in effect, and it will remain in effect till next 9 month when you guys hopefully will issue an order amending 10 the filing date in those rules. 11 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Okay. So by extending the case 12 13 until December, the interim order is still in effect, which 14 does allow for filing of C-111s and C-112s on the 15th day 15 of the second month following production? 16 MR. CARROLL: That is correct. 17 CHAIRMAN LEMAY: Okay, thank you, Mr. Carroll. Is there any discussion on Case Number 10,907? 18 Does anyone have anything to add to that? 19 If not, that case will be taken under advisement 20 and we'll have final action on that case in December. 21 22 (Thereupon, these proceedings were concluded at 23 9:08 a.m.) 24 25
