





1. Applicant is the operator of the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 36, Township 11 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico and proposes to drill its State Well No. 1-36 in the Devonian formation, Gladiola Devonian Oil Pool, at an unorthodox location 2403 feet from the North line and 2620 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 36.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 104 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Division to permit the drilling of this well at the above-described location.
3. The above-described 40-acre standard proration unit should be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will afford applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil and gas from the Devonian formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.



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


