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**CASE \_\_\_\_\_**: Application of Marathon Oil Company for compulsory pooling including a possible unorthodox well location and a non-standard gas proration and spacing unit, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Cisco formation underlying Section 36, T20-1/2S, R23E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, forming either a standard 345.4-acre oil-gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within said vertical extent, which may presently include but is not necessarily limited to the South Dagger Draw-Upper Pennsylvanian Associated Pool, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE forming a non-standard 345.4-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 640-acre spacing within said vertical extent, which may presently include but is not necessarily limited to the Indian Basin Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to a well to be drilled and completed at a well location 660 feet FNL and 1650 feet FEL of Section 36, said location being unorthodox if dedicated to the Indian Basin Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the costs thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as the operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said unit is located approximately 10 miles southeast from Hope, New Mexico.
