Coastal Oil & Gas Corporation, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant seeks approval of an unorthodox well location for an oil well to be drilled to a proposed depth of 10,000 feet from the surface in the Baum Pennsylvanian field in the SW1/4 of Section 31, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant proposes to drill the well 1980 feet from the West line and 990 feet from the South line of the Section.


3. The SW1/4 of Section 31 is to be dedicated to the well.

4. Approval of the unorthodox location will be in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.
