A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Phillips Oil Company, by and through its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and applies to New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for authority to dispose of produced salt water into the Ranger Lake - Penn Pool in the perforated interval from 10,228 feet to 10,346 feet in its Ranger #6 Well located in Unit N, Section 23, T12S, R34E, NMPM, Lea County, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant is the operator of its Ranger #6 well located in Unit N of Section 23, T12S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant seeks authority to dispose of salt water in the Ranger Lake - Penn Pool through perforations at 10228 feet to 10346 feet.

3. Applicant is preparing Division Form C-108 and will submit that application separate from this application.

4. Wherefore, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing and that after notice and hearing the application be granted.
