

A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Cities Service Oil & Gas Corporation, by its attorneys, Kellahin & Kellahin, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for approval of an unorthodox gas well location in the Burton Flats Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, at a location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 21, T21S, R27E, NMPM, with the N/2 of said section being dedicated to the well, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant is the operator and has the right to drill and develop the N/2 of Section 21, T21S, R27E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in the Burton Flats Morrow Gas Pool.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Governmental A-D Well #3 at an unorthodox location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 21.

3. That said location is the location which the BLM will approve for development of the Burton Flats Morrow Pool in the N/2 of said Section 21.

4. That approval of the application will be in the best interests of conservation, the protection of correlative rights and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing and that after said hearing the application be granted as requested.
