APPLICATION

Amerind Oil Co., by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an Order pooling all interests in the Pennsylvanian Formation underlying the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, located in the Northeast Lovington - Pennsylvanian Pool, and in support thereof would show:

1. Applicant is entitled to proceed with the drilling of a well located in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, under the authority of Applicant's ownership of an oil and gas leasehold interest therein.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its #2 Speight well at a legal location in said S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, to a depth of approximately 11,600 feet to test the Pennsylvanian Formation and seeks to dedicate the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28 to the well. Applicant requested the parties listed on the attached schedule as owners of undivided mineral interests in S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 to agree to lease, participate in the drilling of said well or to farmout or otherwise commit their interests to said well, but the parties so far have refused to do so.


3. Applicant seeks that the Division consider the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charge for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

4. The pooling of all interests in the Pennsylvanian Formation in S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28 is in the interest of conservation and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

5. Applicant respectfully requests the setting of this matter before the Division at its regular hearing on September 5, 1984.
