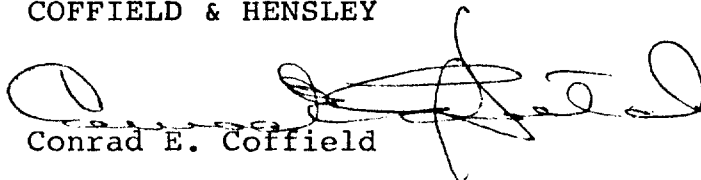
This will confirm our telephone conversation on Thursday, August 30, 1984 in connection with the two referenced cases.

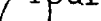
