A When we originally bought this lease, the Collier No. 10 Well, which is almost in the center of the 40 there, is a San Andres well but it was only drilled to 25 -- just a hair below 2500.

We have lower pay zones in there. This well was not completed or anything in that -- in the lower horizons, so we want to move up in this upper corner up here and drill the Collier State 15 and the only way we could get away from these Seven Rivers wells, these, as you're looking

A In my discussion with them I have not discussed this exact location. My discussion with them in the past is if you are as much as 100-150 feet away from us we don't see no problem.
