

CARR: Mr. Examiner, are 16 the witness' qualifications acceptable? 17 MR. STOGNER: They are. Nearburg, would you briefly state 0 Mr. 18 what Chama seeks with this application? 19 Α Chama seeks an unorthodox well location 20 1980 from the north line and 660 feet from the east line. 21 Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, to test 22 Pennsylvanian and Wolfcamp formations, with the north half 23 of the section dedicated to that well. 24 If you were dedicating a stand-up unit 25 consisting of the east half of this section, the well would

So you're not crowding any other operator 0 18 in the area? 19 No. Α 20 In your opinion would granting this ap-0 21 plication impair the correlative rights of any operator 22 the area? 23 No. 24 0 Will it prevent waste? 25 Α Yes, strike that. No.
