APPLICATION OF CHAMA PETROLEUM COMPANY FOR AN UNORTHODOX WELL LOCATION, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 a.m. on September 19, 1984, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 28th day of September, 1984, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Chama Petroleum Company, seeks approval of an uncrthodox gas well location for the Samedan Oil Corporation Ivey Comm. Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, which was plugged and abandoned August 7, 1974.
- (3) The applicant proposes to re-enter and test the Pennsylvanian and Wolfcamp formations in said well.
- (4) The N/2 of said Section 5 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (5) A well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.
- (6) No offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

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(7) Approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the affected pool(s) and/or formations, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) The application of Chama Petroleum Company for an unorthodox gas well location for the Pennsylvanian and Wolfcamp formations is hereby approved for the Samedan Cil Corporation Ivey Comm. Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (2) The N/2 of said Section 5 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.
- (3) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
