## APPLICATION

COMES NOW Yates Petroleum Corporation, a New Mexico corporation, by its attorneys, pursuant to §70-2-1, et seq., N.M.S.A. (1978), and requests that the Division enter an order approving a unit agreement, and in support hereof, states:

- 1. Yates Petroleum Corporation, as operator, proposes the formation of an exploratory unit, consisting of state, federal and fee lands covering approximately 122,600 acres in Townships 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 North, and Ranges 6, 7 and 8 East, in Santa Fe and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico.
- 2. The proposed Unit Agreement and Unit Operating Agreement covering the manner in which the unit will be supervised and managed, and costs allocated and paid, will be submitted at hearing on this Application.
- 3. The granting of this Application will be in the interest of conservation, will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this matter be set for hearing, and upon hearing, the Division enter its order approving operator's Unit Agreement for the Caja Del Rio Grande Unit Area hereinabove defined, and for such other and further relief as to the Division seems proper.
