Comes now, DOYLE HARTMAN, by his undersigned attorneys, and hereby makes application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for reinstatement of cancelled underproduction, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show the Division:

1. Applicant operates the Shell State #2 and #5 Wells located in Units P and J, respectively, on his Shell State Lease comprised of 160 acres located in the SE/4 of Section 13, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. That due to the refusal of the pipeline to take the gas allowable assigned to the proration unit described in paragraph 1 above, the unit was at various times since mid-1982 reclassified back to non-marginal status, but the accrued underproduction for the proration unit was not reinstated resulting in the loss to applicant of thousands of cubic feet of gas which he had previously been entitled to produce.

3. Applicant seeks an order reinstating the cancelled underproduction for his Shell State Lease.


4. That granting this application will not cause waste nor impair the correlative rights of any interest owner in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
