3 1 2 QUINTANA: We'll call next MR. 3 Case 8427. 4 RICHARDSON: MR. Randolph M. 5 Richardson, Roswell, New Mexico, appearing on behalf of the 6 applicant. 7 And I'll hand you the geologi-8 cal report, as well as the revised Exhibits A and B for the unit agreement. 9 Mr. Wilde has already been 10 sworn and qualified. Do you want to re-swear him? 11 MR. QUINTANA: No. 12 MR. RICHARDSON: He's consid-13 ered under oath still. 14 15 GARNER L. WILDE, 16 being called as a witness and having been previously sworn upon his oath, testified as follows, to-wit: 17 18 DIRECT EXAMINATION 19 BY MR. RICHARDSON: 20 Mr. Wilde, is the form of unit agreement 0 21 the Flying H Unit as prescribed by Federal regulations for 22 and as recently approved by the Commissioner of Public 23 Lands? 24 Α Yes. Has the unit are been designated by 25 Q the

4 1 Bureau of Land Management as an area logically suitable for 2 development under a unit plan of development? 3 А Yes. The unit area has been designated 4 by the BLM. 5 Q Has the Commissioner of Public Lands for 6 the State of New Mexico approved this unit? 7 Ά Commissioner has approved the The unit 8 agreement as to its form and content. 9 0 Would you please tell the Division the townships and ranges in which this unit is located and the 10 approximate location with reference to the nearest town? 11 Α The unit area is located in the southeast 12 portion of Township 14 South, Range 19 East, and the east 13 half of Township 15 South, Range 19 East, ard in the south-14 west portion of Township 15 South, Range 20 East, New Mexico 15 Post Meridian, Chaves County, New Mexico. 16 The unit area is approximately 35 miles 17 southwest of the town of Roswell. 0 Could you please tell the Division 18 the total number of acres within the unit area and the number 19 and percentage of acreage of Federal, State, and fee land? 20 The unit area contains 18,301.69 acres of Α 21 which 13,810.68 acres, or 75.46 percent are Federal land; 22 3,291.01 acres, or 17.98 percent are State land; and 1,200 23 acres, or 6.56 percent are fee or private lard. 24 Could you please refer to the geological 0 25 report which has been handed to the Examiner and marked Ex-

5 1 hibits One through Six? Was this report prepared by you? 2 Α Yes. The report was prepared by me with 3 cooperation from other Harper employees and McClellan Oil 4 Corporation. 5 Could you please briefly review the re-0 6 port, referring to the maps by name, indicating the signifi-7 cance of such maps? 8 Exhibit One is a land plat showing Ά the 9 outline of the unit and the proposed locatior. Exhibit Two is a geological map for the 10 Snake Eyes and the Flying H Ranch Federal Units area. 11 Exhibit Three is a structure map on top 12 the Tubb formation for the Flying H Ranch Federal of Unit; 13 contour interval 100 feet. 14 Exhibit Four is a structure map, also on 15 top of the Tubb, with the same contour interval of 100 feet. 16 This covers the entire southwest Chaves County prospect 17 area, the two units. And Exhibit Five is a structural cross 18 section A-A', essentially east/west, that goes across each 19 of the two prospective areas. 20 Exhibit Six is a brief geological report 21 for the Flying H Ranch Federal Unit. 22 0 Could you please tell the Division your 23 to the formations likely to be encountered conclusions as 24 and considered prospective for production? 25 The formations to be encountered would be Α

6 1 the entire Paleozoic section beneath the San Andres and each 2 would be prospective in its own right; however, we would be 3 targetting Abo formation, Pennsylvanian formations, and the 4 Fusselman Montoya section. 5 Could you tell the Division the projected 0 6 depth and location for the initial test well? 7 It would be a 5000-foot well located 660 Α 8 feet from the north line, 660 feet from the west line of Section 24, Township 15 South, Range 19 East. 9 Q Can you please tell the Division the 10 working interest ownership and percentages within the unit 11 area, and have these owners been contacted? 12 Ά McClellan Oil Corporation has 37.41 per-13 cent; Harper Oil Company, 30.33 percent; ANR Production Com-14 pany, 10.55 percent; Gulf Oil Corporation, 6.59 percent; and 15 other small owners total 15.12 percent. 16 And, yes, all working interest owners have been contacted. 17 In your opinion what percentage of 0 the 18 working interest will be committed and what percentage of 19 the royalty will be committed? 20 The working interest will be 90 percent Α 21 committed and it's estimated that 90 percent of the royalty 22 will be committed. 23 If Gulf Oil Corporation should finally 24 decide to commit to this unit, the unit would be 97 percent 25 committed as to working interest and royalty interest.

7 1 In your opinion will the operation of Q 2 this area under the proposed unit plan of cperation be in 3 the interest of conservation and prevention cf waste? 4 Α Yes, it would. 5 0 Will the different institutions of the 6 if any, receive their fair share of production, if State, 7 established? 8 Α Yes, they would. In the event of production will the cor-0 9 relative rights of all parties to the unit acreement be pro-10 tected? 11 Α Yes. 12 MR. RICHARDSON: I have no fur-13 ther questions. 14 I'd like to move the geological 15 report be admitted into evidence. 16 MR. OUINTANA: Exhibits One through Six will be entered in evidence. 17 MR. TAYLOR: Do you have the 18 tentative approval by BLM and the State Land Office in 19 writing? Did they write to you or is that just oral? 20 MR. RICHARDSON: I have the 21 State letter. 22 MR. TAYLOR: Could you provide 23 those to us? 24 MR. **RICHARDSON**: I will. Ι 25 don't think I brought them with me.

8 1 Okay, just send MR. TAYLOR: 2 them. 3 MR. RICHARDSON: And the Fed-4 eral is in the mail now. I talked to them yesterday and he 5 is sending that on to me or mailed it yesterday. 6 You could just MR. TAYLOR: 7 send us a copy of it. 8 MR. RICHARDSON: The Feds, I think, will send you one anyway, but I'll -- I'll send you 9 one, also. 10 And that's for both units. 11 MR.
