Reference is made to the Application of Lynx Petroleum for Approval of an Unorthodox Well Location, Compulsory Pooling and Dual Completion, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is noted in the application that Lynx alleges that "applicant has sought to obtain the cooperation of all parties".

We would refer you to our letter dated March 28, 1985, in which we stated that your proposal for recompleting in the Queen zone held some interest for us, however, the terms you offered were not acceptable.

Since the well was initially drilled to the Paddock formation and completed, Texaco does not feel that it should pay a part of the initial cost of drilling this test. We would still be interested in participating in the recompletion attempt in the Queen formation, paying our proportionate part of this cost.
