FIRST AMENDED APPLICATION

Applicant states:

1. That it is the operator of the Canada Ojitos Unit which is governed by the West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool Special Rules promulgated under the captioned orders of the Oil Conservation Commission.

2. That the western boundary of the Canada Ojitos Unit and the West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool are immediatley adjacent to the eastern boundary of the Gavilan-Mancos Oil Pool.

3. That the West Puerto Chiquito Mancos Oil Pool special rules provide for 640 acre spacing with well locations to be no closer that 1,650 feet to the outer boundary of the proration unit and no closer that 330 feet to a quarter section line.

4. That the Gavilan Mancos Oil Pool special pool rules provides for 320 acre spacing and allow no more than one well in the East one-half of any section that is contiguous with the western boundary of the West Puerto Chiquito Oil Pool, with said well being located no closer that 1,650 feet to said boundary.

5. That the West Puerto Chiquito Oil Pool is a gravity drainage reservoir significantly affected by applicant's pressure maintenance operations for the Canada Ojitos Unit.

6. That in order to protect its correlative rights and to promote orderly development along the common boundary of the West Puerto Chiquito Oil Pool and the Gavilan Mancos Oil Pool, applicant proposes amendments to the West Puerto Chiquito Pool Rules. Such proposed amendments include:

> (a) To allow the drilling of a second well on any proration unit within the Canada Ojitos Unit on any proration unit on the western-most two rows of sections in such Unit adjoining the Gavilan Mancos Pool.

(b) Only one well shall be allowed to be drilled in the west one-half of the row of sections which border the Gavilan Mancos Oil Pool

(c) That the method of calculating allowables for the Pool should be adjusted as follows:

The top allowable for proration units in the Pool should be equal to two times the top allowable for proration units in the Gavilan Mancos Oil Pool, except that wells located closer than 2,310 feet from the Gavilan Mancos Pool Boundary shall not be allowed to produce a share of its proration unit's top allowable in excess of the top allowable for a well in the Gavilan Mancos Oil Pool.

(d) For such further rules and regulations as are just under the circumstances.

Wherefore, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing at the earliest available Division hearing and that upon hearing the application be approved.
