Gentlemen:

The Commissioner of Public Lands hereby supports and endorses Mr. Doyle Hartman's application for a non-standard 200 acre proration unit consisting of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, Lea County. The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 is the only state acreage not included in any proration unit for the gas production from the Jalmat Gas Pool in this area.

It is essential that this NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 be included in a proration unit and receive its fair share of the production from the Jalmat Gas Pool to keep this acreage from being drained and for the protection of correlative rights of this Trust Land.




