# Gentlemen:

The Commissioner of Public Lands hereby supports and endorses Mr. Doyle Hartman's application for a non-standard 200 acre proration unit consisting of the SE% Section 25 and the NE%NE% Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, Lea County. The NE%NE% of Section 36 is the only state acreage not included in any proration unit for the gas production from the Jalmat Gas Pool in this area.

#### Gentlemen:
