6 your credentials as a petroleum geologist accepted, have you
7 not?

8 A Yes, I have.

9 MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I
10 tender the witness as an expert petroleum geologist.

11 MR. STOGNER: Let the record so
12 show that he was previously qualified.

13 Q Mr. Kautz, are you prepared to make re-
14 commendations to the Examiner today concerning the nomencla-
15 ture in certain pools in Lea County, New Mexico?

16 A Yes, I am.

17 Q Are your recommendations prepared in the
18 form of an exhibit?

19 A Yes, in Exhibit Number One.

20 Q Would you please refer to your Exhibit
21 Number One and to the docket that's been prepared and dis-
22 tributed at the hearing this morning and point out any dif-
23 ferences between the two?

24 A There is no difference.

25 Q Do you have anything further to add to

1 your testimony?

2 A Nothing further.

3 Q Did you prepare or was Exhibit Number One
4 prepared under your supervision and control?

5 A It was prepared under my supervision.

6 MR. TAYLOR: Mr. Examiner, I'd
7 like to move the admission of Exhibit One.

8 MR. STOGNER: Exhibit One will
9 be admitted into evidence.

10 MR. TAYLOR: There is nothing
11 further.

12 MR. STOGNER: Does anybody else
13 have anything further in Case Number 8791?

14 If not, Mr. Kautz, you may step
15 down and Case Number 8791 will be taken under advisement.
